## IDES (Illinois Department of Employment Security) - Identity Theft

- 1) If you receive an unsolicited debit card from IDES or KeyBank –DO NOT ACTIVATEIT!
- 2) If you receive a bank debit card from KeyBank or any other bank, contact that bank's fraud department and have the account closed
