
#### VIEWS FROM THE DESK OF ...

## PBA administers our Medical, Dental and Vision Insurance. *CIGNA is only our PPO Network*.

Sometimes doctors' offices see the CIGNA logo on our insurance card and assume we have Cigna insurance. Consequently, they may call CIGNA to verify coverage and are told there is no coverage. **If that happens, remind your doctors to call PBA instead to verify coverage.** When completing forms, list your insurance as PBA, not CIGNA.
