It likely is a combination of factors – some of which, I would submit, apply to an enduring city or organization. Talent, dedication, an uncompromising commitment to quality, strong

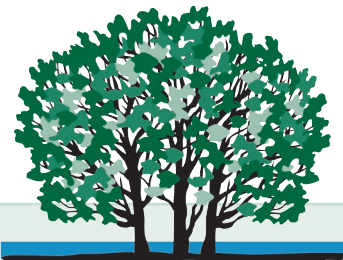

She likes watching the Cubs, going to the beach and traveling.



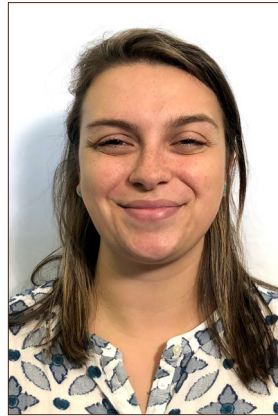
Laura Larsen also joins the Police Department as a Police Officer.

Laura likes swimming, sports, reading and is an animal lover.



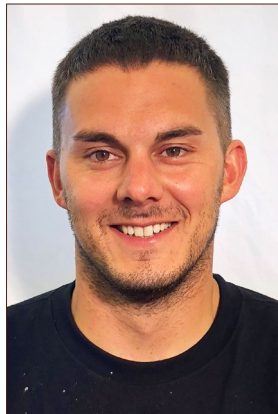

Austin is married with 2 children. He likes golfing and spending time with his family.



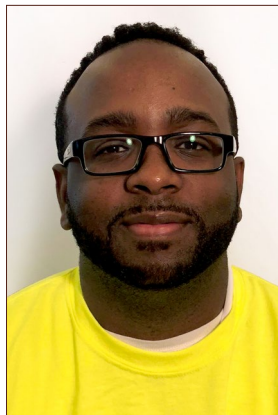
Jennifer Baehr joins us as the Assistant Planner in Community Development. She was previously an architectural reviewer with The City of Indianapolis.

Jen enjoys hiking, camping, cooking and seeing live music.



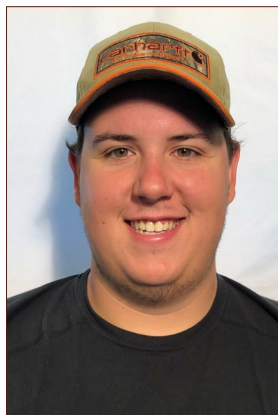
Kevin Hill joins Public Works Fleet Department as a Mechanic. He comes to the City from Wirfs Industries where he worked as a mechanic.
